1. **19/00923/FUL** | Change of use from dwelling house to 6-bed HMO | 201 Citadel Road East

**EXISTING APPLICATIONS**

2. **19/00280/FUL** | Statue to commemorate Lady Nancy Astor in front of Elliot Terrace

Permission granted for statue on grassed area with an increased paved area around the statue but no solid path. There is a requirement for “All relevant parties to consider and negotiate a suitable access to the statue subject to all other relevant considerations”.

Two applications at rear of 1 Elliot Terrace

3. **19/00284/FUL** | Extension above the rear second floor to form a 1-bed apartment - Granted  
**19/00304/FUL** | Conversion of Ground Floor garage to 1-bed apartment - Pending decision
4. **19/00155/FUL** | Erection of single storey pavilion for a new baby unit at the McMillan Nursery, 24 Hoe Street  
Granted.
5. **18/00234/S73** - Quality Hotel Site - 1620 application was granted on the 15<sup>th</sup> Sept 2017 and must be started within two years.
  - Contribution to PCC of £1m for affordable housing elsewhere
  - Hoe Link Works Contribution of £240k for works, as agreed with the Council, for pavement works, removal of overhangs/shelters along Cliff Rd and potentially a new access from Cliff Rd onto the Hoe.

**NEW APPLICATION**

1. **072730** - Application to vary the premises license at the Terrace Café, Madeira Road, The Hoe

Performance of live/recorded music (Outdoors) & alcohol for consumption ON the premises, by:

- Increasing the licensed area by including the upper tier for the sale of alcohol.
- Extending the opening hours and licensed activities from Midnight until 1am
- Allow late night refreshment (food) until 1am

Additional restriction added that “Between the hours of 11pm and 8am noise emanating from the Terrace must be inaudible at the nearest residential property”.
